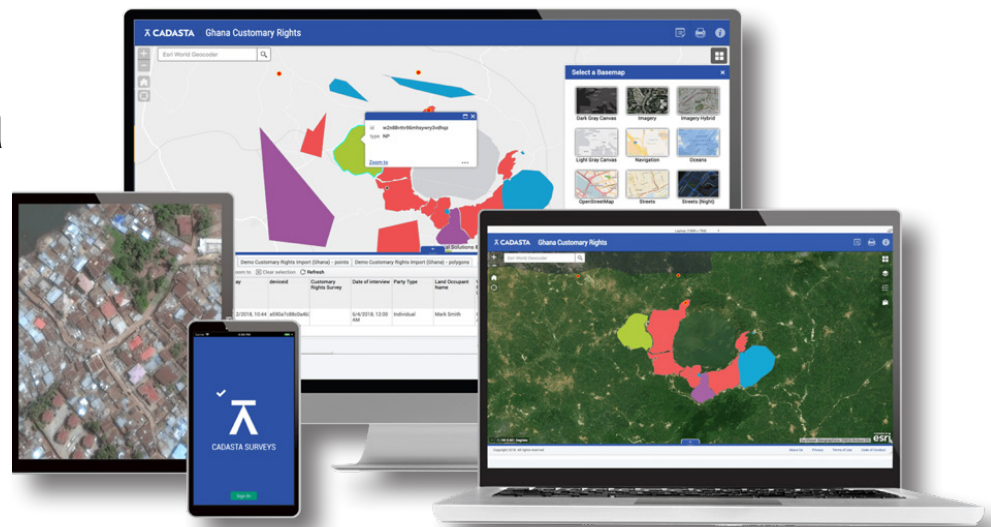
Through tailored data integration and analytics services, we help transform scattered project-level data into cohesive, interactive dashboards that illustrate how and where progress is being made.

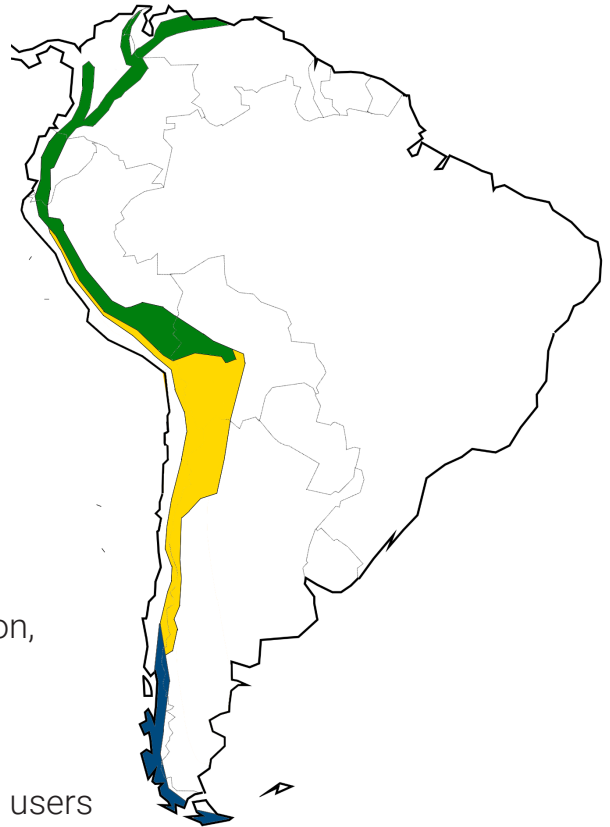
Data Visualization with Rights and Resources Initiative (RRI)

Over the past four years, RRI and its partners have collaborated with 23 local organizations across the Tropical Andes in South America to implement 71 projects, strengthening territorial governance and securing tenure rights across more than 100 million hectares.

To capture these achievements and guide future action, Cadasta consolidated, standardized, and visualized complex territorial data from diverse local sources.

The data became accessible and actionable, helping users see where Indigenous and Afro-descendant organizations are advancing tenure and governance initiatives.

The maps also integrated 2024 deforestation data from Global Forest Watch, providing valuable context on how tenure security and forest conservation intersect across the Andes.
