**THE NEED:** Over 1 billion people feel insecure about their land rights, living on land they cannot prove is theirs.

**THE PROBLEM:** Lack of data and access to technology and digital skills makes communities invisible and vulnerable.

#### BRING LAND INTO VIEW

Communities map and monitor their land, creating the data needed to secure rights, livelihoods, and climate outcomes.
